All that portion Lot 1 of Base Line Short Plat, according to the Plat recorded in Volume 21 of Short Plats Page 55 and 56 under AF. No. 1239324, records of Grant County, Washington. Situate in Government Lot 4, Section 18, Township 20 North, Range 24 E, W.M., City of Quincy, Washington.

EXCEPT the following described Tract: Beginning at the Northwesterly corner of said lot 1 being common to the southwesterly corner of Lot 2 of said Baseline Plat, and on the easterly right of way of 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW. Thence S0°22'30"W along said Easterly right of way 458.53 feet. Thence S0°89 55'35"E 570.00 feet. Thence N0°22'30"E 458.53 feet to the Southeasterly corner of said Lot 2.
