QVBCC: Commissioners approved Kallstrom Sweet Corn to rent the parking lot of the Main Hall for \$50 a week.

Darci Kleyn said the tiles that were ordered for the Main Hall have arrived.

INTERMODAL (CAPITAL BUDGET GRANT): Commissioner Connelly said he met with HNTB and Pat Boss to start working on a rail design.

RACEWAY: Commissioner Morris reported he met with G&O and Raceway to discuss power issues.
