QVBCC: Darci Kleyn said we have requested cleaning quotes from a couple local companies.

INTERMODAL: Commissioner Morris reported Gavin Galbraith is working on getting everything cleaned up and organized. Darci Kleyn said Mr. Galbraith has asked for a computer to keep all maintenance records and will need a work email. Commissioners agreed to pull a laptop from the Port meeting rooms and utilize for Intermodal.

RACEWAY: Commissioner Morris said the transformer has been delivered and is currently being installed.

PARK 9: Commissioner Morris said Travest Story and Mark Kyrilov met regarding a 5 acres parcel.

INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER: Commissioner Kuest said we are still waiting on the transfer agreement with the City of Quincy.

Commissioner Morris said Intermountain is interested in using the trench to place fiberoptic. Brandon Mauseth said sharing the trench would be a great cost sharing program. Maintenance and repairs would have to be laid out in a contract.

Commissioner Morris said he is working on Schorzman's land lease.

EDC: Darci Kleyn reported the new Big Bend Community College President gave a presentation.

HOSPITAL: Commissioner Kuest said Pat Boss was working on making sure the Department of Commerce would approve the Buxton assessment for our current remaining grant.

COLOCKUM RIDGE GOLF COURSE: Commissioner Connelly reported we passed the 5-year County Health Inspection for the water system.

Commissioner Connelly said Faustino Chavez has training scheduled for the maintenance of the golf course machinery.

BISHOP: Commissioner Morris said he was working on getting a quote to clean up the Bishop house.
