**QVBCC:** Commissioner Connelly said Basin Refrigeration will be in to replace toilets on September 29, 2021. The sink project is still in the middle of scheduling due to staff shortage.

A special meeting will be set up for Commissioner's to meet with the new hires on Friday, October 1<sup>st</sup> to discuss the future of the QVBCC.

**COLOCKUM RIDGE GOLF COURSE:** Gabe Porter said he received a quote from Toro for a new Fairway Mower in the amount of \$75,653.25 and a Turbine Blower in the amount of \$10,000.00. Mr. Porter reported the price might go up about 10% over time due to price increase. Commissioner Connelly asked Mr. Porter to check into the lease to own program if offered. No action was taken.

Commissioner Morris reported Aspect Consulting is working on a potential permit to drill a new well.

**PROPOSED** – **INDUSTRIAL PARK 8:** Commissioner Morris reported the stringing of the pipe from the bridge was approved. Commissioner Morris said the project is on hold until finances are figured out.

HOSPITAL: Commissioner Kuest reported they are looking to see if the design in feasible for the cost.

**INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER:** Commissioner Morris reported the transferring of the total project to the Industrial Users Group is complete.
