QBEC: Connie Kuest stated the Ducks Unlimited auction went well and spring clean up will begin soon.

COLOCKUM RIDGE GOLF COURSE: Gabe Porter stated the course has been busy and they hosted a Highschool tournament yesterday. Gabe then stated that Raceways Technology has purchased a corporate membership. Gabe also expressed interest in selling a mower that is no longer being used and instead purchasing a new tow-behind turbine blower.
